

Connor Earl Photography COVID-19 Safety Protocols

The Government of Ontario has put in place specific protocols to help limit the spread of COVID-19 and the COVID-19 variants. Connor Earl Photography takes the safety of our staff and clients very seriously. In keeping with the Ontario COVID-19 protocols, here is what we will do should we do any **onsite photoshoots, video shoots, or contact with clients** during booked periods within the pandemic:

1) Wearing Masks or Facial Coverings / Social Distancing

- Any onsite shoot or where in contact with people
- Maintain a distance of 6ft at all times with client(s)
 - o If need to be closer than 6ft for any reason, employees will have mask + face shield
- Use of longer reaching lenses to help maintain the 6ft distance

2) Washing Equipment / High Traffic Areas Frequently

- Sanitization of all equipment (cameras, tripods, props, etc.) before and after each session with a client

3) Limit the Number of People Present

- As of July 21, 2021, under Stage 3 of Ontario's reopening plan, the numbers are 5 people indoors & 25 people outdoors
- Connor Earl Photography is limiting the number of people at shoots to just 5 people indoors and 12 people outdoors keeping with physical distancing

4) Space out Appointments & Session

- Appointments and Sessions will be scheduled in advance to allow at least 1 hour in between to sanitize and disinfect where applicable

5) Require all Staff Members and Clients to fill out a COVID-19 Screening Self-Assessment

- Self-Assessment is clear, everything will continue, still keeping all COVID-19 protocols
- Self-Assessment is negative, the following will happen:
 - o STAFF: the staff member will not be allowed to work until proof of a negative COVID-19 test
 - o CLIENT: Client appointment or session will be postponed

6) Follow ALL COVID-19 Safety guidelines from the Government of Ontario and the Government of Canada
